Readings from *Disce! An Introductory Latin Course*.

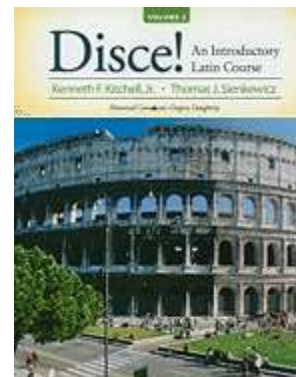
Recommended for students transitioning from LATN102 or from high school Latin.

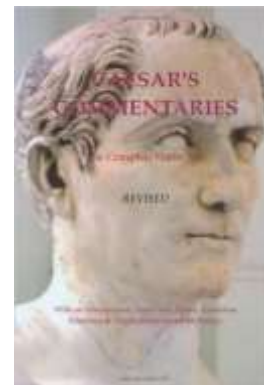
### Section 2: Caesar's *Commentaries*
